The local organizers will evaluate all submissions and communicate acceptance decisions by April 15. Presenters of accepted papers should confirm their participation by May 1st. The application should include a curriculum vitae (with university, thesis advisor's name and area of interest)

There will be no conference fee. The organizers cover accommodation and reimburse travel costs for participating students.
