

A short PhD course on  
Public Economics  
Helsinki, 4-6 June 2020

Welcome to a PhD-course in Public Economics taking place directly after the meeting of TAPES (Trans-Atlantic Public Economics Seminar), which brings together some of the world's leading public economics researchers. The course starts in the afternoon Thursday the 4<sup>th</sup> and ends early afternoon Saturday the 6<sup>th</sup>.

The course will start with two keynote lectures by Jonathan Gruber and Hillary Hoynes. Thereafter follows lectures on different topics in public economics including optimal taxation, empirical tax analysis and behavioural public economics. In addition, students are invited to give flash talks, presenting ongoing work. Conditional on presenting and supervisor's approval, the course will give credits.

The organizers have limited funds to cover the travel costs from students residing outside of Helsinki and in other Nordic countries.
